### What's in a book?

#### Joshua

The book follows on from Deuteronomy. The Israelites are poised to enter the Promised Land. The LORD divided the waters of the Jordan allowing them to cross as if on dry land. The familiar story of how the city of Jericho was captured [Joshua 6:] is followed by successes against most of the other tribes in the land of Canaan. [Joshua 11: 12: ]. The lands were then divided up between the twelve tribes [Joshua 13: to 22:] The book ends with a renewal of the Covenant with the LORD. Joshua died and was buried at Timnath Serah in the hill country of Ephraim [Joshua 24: 29]. The Israelites continued to serve the LORD during the lives of the Elders who had experienced everything that the LORD had done for the Israel [Joshua 24: 31]

#### Judges

The book covers a long period where the Israelites fluctuated in their relationship with the LORD. They adopted the gods of the peoples round about them and became subject to military defeats at their hands. Over these years the LORD appointed a series of military leaders known as Judges who were enabled to bring the Israelites back to the LORD but only during the lifetime of that Judge. The Judges include Othniel, Ehud, Deborah, Gideon, Jephthah, Samson. Shamgar, Tola, Jair, Ibzan, Elon, and Abdon.
